5 Beloved, it is a faithful thing you do in all your efforts for these brothers, strangers as they are, 6 who testified to your love before the church. You will do well to send them on their journey in a manner worthy of God. 7 For they have gone out for the sake of the Name, accepting nothing from the Gentiles. 8 Therefore we ought to support people like these, that we may be fellow workers for the truth.

SETTING & BACKGROUND of 3rd JOHN:

- 1. John a disciple of Jesus is the writer... also called 'the Elder'.
- 2. This John also wrote the Gospel of John and Revelation.
- **3.** The little letters of 1st, 2nd and 3rd John were likely sent <u>together</u>.
 - 1st John was a <u>sermon</u> to churches in what is now western Turkey.
 - 2nd John was a <u>letter</u> to a particular church.
 - 3rd John was <u>personal correspondence</u> to a man name Gaius.
- **4.** Apparently, Gaius was helping <u>traveling missionaries</u> who were passing through their area of Asia (western Turkey).

OBSERVATIONS & APPLICATIONS from 3rd JOHN 5-8

1. Supporting missionaries is <u>a REALLY GOOD thing to do</u>.

vs 5 & 8

- A- we care for them.
- B- we pray for them.
- C- we <u>pay</u> for them.
- 2. Sometimes we know them, sometimes we do not.

vs 5b strangers as they are

5 Beloved, it is a faithful thing you do in all your efforts for these brothers, strangers as they are, 6 who testified to your love before the church. You will do well to send them on their journey in a manner worthy of God. 7 For they have gone out for the sake of the Name, accepting nothing from the Gentiles. 8 Therefore we ought to support people like these, that we may be fellow workers for the truth.

3. We should support missionaries generously.

vs. 6b You will do well to send them on their journey in a manner worthy of God.

Our generosity should be <u>great</u>. Our generosity should be <u>genuine</u>. Our generosity should be <u>glad</u>. *"Not equal <u>gifts</u>, but equal <u>sacrifice</u>."* (The <u>amount</u> counts.) (The <u>authenticity</u> counts.) (The <u>attitude</u> counts.)

4. We should support missionaries because we love Christ.

- vs 7a For they have gone out for the sake of the Name,
- **5. We should support missionaries because it's <u>good strategy</u>. vs 7b [they] accept nothing from the Gentiles.**
- 6. We should support missionaries so we may join their work. vs 8b that we may be fellow workers for the truth.

WHY LOTTIE MOON?? Her Extraordinary Life:

- Born in Virginia Dec. 12, 1840
- Rebelled against Christianity until she came to Christ in college Dec 1858
- One of the first women in the South to receive a master's degree
- Sailed to China in 1873 supported by Southern Baptist churches (IMB = International Mission Board)
- Spent <u>39</u> years teaching girls and women of Shantung, China about Christ
- Wrote thousands of letters campaigning for missions support for China
 - 'Please pray for us.'
 - 'Please give so we can stay.'
 - 'Please send people to help us.'
- Died on a ship in Kobe, Japan <u>Dec 24, 1912</u> at age 73 (109 years ago)
