GOD'S CLEANSING -- BRINGS RESTORATION

ZECHARIAH 3:1-10

DREAM #4 (Joshua the High Priest)

English Standard Version (ESV)

1 Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the Lord, and Satan standing at his right hand to accuse him. 2 And the Lord said to Satan, "The Lord rebuke you, O Satan! The Lord who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is not this a brand plucked from the fire?" 3 Now Joshua was standing before the angel, clothed with filthy garments. 4 And the angel said to those who were standing before him, "Remove the filthy garments from him." And to him he said, "Behold, I have taken your iniquity away from you, and I will clothe you with pure vestments." 5 And I said, "Let them put a clean turban on his head." So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the Lord was standing by.

6 And the angel of the Lord solemnly assured Joshua, 7 "Thus says the Lord of hosts: If you will walk in my ways and keep my charge, then you shall rule my house and have charge of my courts, and I will give you the right of access among those who are standing here. 8 Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, you and your friends who sit before you, for they are men who are a sign: behold, I will bring my servant the Branch. 9 For behold, on the stone that I have set before Joshua, on a single stone with seven eyes, I will engrave its inscription, declares the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of this land in a single day. 10 In that day, declares the Lord of hosts, every one of you will invite his neighbor to come under his vine and under his fig tree."

BACKGROUND & REVIEW

- 1) In Zechariah's day, God's people are at a place of <u>desolation</u> and <u>hopelessness</u> because they did not trust and obey the Lord.
- 2) God, in His tremendous grace, sends Zechariah to call them to <u>repentance</u> and to give them a message of His <u>grace</u> and <u>promise</u> towards them.
 - If they will <u>return to Him</u>, then <u>He will return to them!</u> (Zech 1:3)
 - They were in 'a whole world of hurt' because they had left faith and obedience to God. (Zech 1:4-5)
 - 8 Dreams -- God gives them a second chance through HIS RULE over their lives.
 - **Dream #1** -- God sees them in their mess and promises comfort. (Zech 1:7-17)
 - Dream #2 -- God will punish their enemies as they return to faithful worship. (Zech 1:18-21)
 - Dream #3 -- God's great and gracious restoration will bring his people home to Him. (Zech 2:1-13)
 - Dream #4 -- (our study today) Dreams 4 & 5 are the climax of the 8 dreams... MESSIAH!

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DREAM #4 -- JOSHUA THE HIGH PRIEST (Dirty Garments Changed for Clean Garments)

- 1) See Joshua --> Israel's leader into the Promised Land almost 1,000 years earlier!
 - (the Hebrews in Egypt/Moses --> wilderness --> Moses dies/Joshua leads --> enter Promised Land) (Yahōšua or 'Joshua' in Hebrew, 'Jesus' in Greek literally means 'The LORD saves')
 - Joshua was the high priest responsible for ensuring the purity of God's people (through sacrifice).
- 2) See the progression from earthly enemies (dream#2-- the nations) to the spiritual enemy, Satan.
 - 'Satan' --> literally means 'the accuser' Job 1:11; 2:5;
 - Satan is the one who accuses/attacks God's people... Luke 22:31; 1 Peter 5:8; Rev. 12:10.
 - See that Satan is <u>subservient</u> to the Lord. Satan is <u>silenced</u> by the Lord. vs 1-2
- 3) See God's choosing of His people even through they are still unclean/sinful. vs 2-3 ROMANS 5:6-9

6 For <u>while we were still helpless</u>, at the right time Christ died for <u>the ungodly</u>. 7 For one will hardly die for a righteous person; though perhaps for the good person someone would even dare to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that <u>while we were still sinners</u>, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God <u>through Him</u>.

- 4) See God's Messiah (<u>the Branch</u>) is the sole agent of <u>cleansing</u> and <u>salvation</u>. vs 5, 6-9

 JEREMIAH 23:5-6 (also see Jeremiah 33:15; Isaiah 4:2; 11:1; Zechariah 6:12; John 15)
 - 5 "Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The Lord is our righteousness.'
- 5) See that restoration with <u>God</u> leads to restoration with <u>others!</u> vs 10

See Matthew 22:37-40 The Great Commandments: <u>Love GOD</u>, <u>love OTHERS</u>. Proof positive that someone <u>truly knows God</u> is that they truly <u>love His people</u>.
