## 2<sup>nd</sup> JOHN 1:4-6

**1** The elder to the elect lady and her children, whom I love in **truth**, and not only I, but also all who know the **truth**, **2** because of the **truth** that abides in us and will be with us <u>forever</u>:

**3** Grace, mercy, and peace will be with us, from God the Father and from Jesus Christ the Father's Son, in truth and love.

4 I rejoiced greatly to find some of your children walking in the **truth**, just as we were commanded by the Father. 5 And now I ask you, dear lady—not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we love one another. 6 And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it.

	<b>Verses 1-3</b> are unmistakably emphasizing the massive importance of staying in the truth.					
	Verses 4-6 reveal the fundamental indicator that a church or an individual are in the truth					
	See <b>1 John 2:9-11</b>					
	9 Whoever says he is in the light and hates his brother is still in dark-					
	ness. 10 Whoever loves his brother abides in the light, and in him there is no cause					
	for stumbling. 11 But whoever hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the					
	darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded					
	his eyes.

	<ul><li>What does it mean to 'walk in the truth'?</li></ul>					
	it means coming to <u>the truth</u> (the reality of Christ, salvation, God's Word)					
	it means coming to the truth (John 3:15; 5:24; 19:35; 20:31; 1 John 5:13)					
	it means coming to the truth in your daily life (John 14:15, 21; Luke 6:46; Matt 7:21; James 1:22					
	it means becoming in the way you live					
	it means showing and speaking <u>Christ's</u> to a lost and broken world
